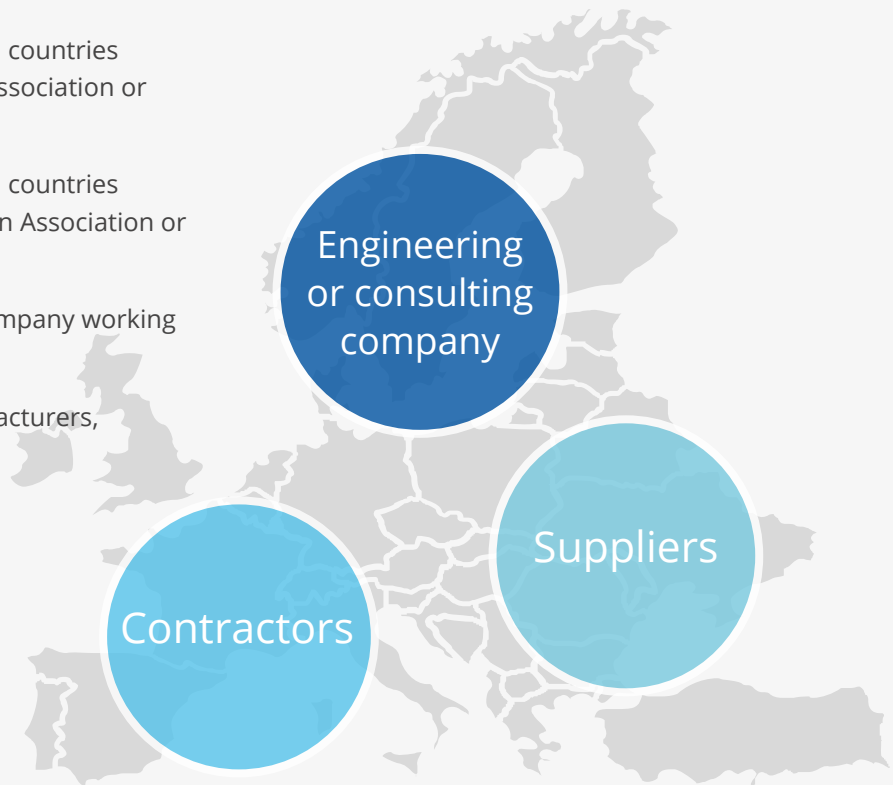

How to become a member?

If you are interested in becoming a member of the EDA, the incorporation process is as follows:

- »» Fill and send to the association the appropriate application form (see next page).
- »» Your application form will be assessed by the EDA Board of Directors. Additional information might be required.
- »» Once your request is admitted, the EDA Secretariat will contact you, sending you the registration notification.
- »» Pay the annual fee established by the General Assembly of the association.

In general, any entity wishing to join must apply in writing, provided the following minimum requirements:

- »» Lawfully formed companies or associations.
- »» The activity of the company or association must be linked directly to the demolition industry.
